The legal voters of the Town of Elmore are hereby warned and notified to meet at the Elmore Town Office in said Town on March 2nd, 2021 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. to transact the following business by **Australian ballot**:

ARTICLE 1: To Elect the Following:

- Moderator - 1 year
- Town Clerk - 1 year
- Town Treasurer - 1 year
- Select Board - 3 year
- Lister - 3 years
- Auditor - 3 years
- Auditor - 1 year
- Delinquent Tax Collector - 1 year
- Constable - 1 year
- Trustee of Public Funds - 1 year
- Cemetery Commission - 5 years
- Cemetery Commission - 2 years
- Lamoille Solid Waste Mgmt. Supervisor - 2 years

ARTICLE 2: Shall the Town vote to assess a 1% local room option tax on short term rental properties, with the Town's share of the revenues of such tax to be used for capital projects within the Town of Elmore, Pursuant to the Town's Municipal Charter?

ARTICLE 4: Shall the Town vote to raise money equal to those expenditures approved in Article 3 on its Grand List for the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 to pay debts and current expenditures of the Town, Payable in Two equal installments on September 15th 2021 and March 15th 2022?

ARTICLE 5: Shall the Town vote apply any surplus from the current fiscal year to reduce taxes in the next fiscal year 2021-2022?

ARTICLE 6: Shall the Town vote to call the next annual meeting of the Town of Elmore on the first Tuesday of March 2022 at 9:00 A.M.?
