SPECIAL MEETING, MARCH 5, 2019

WARNING

The legal voters of the Town of Elmore, Vermont, are hereby notified and warned to meet at the Elmore Town Office on Tuesday, March 5, 2019, between the hours of eight o'clock (8:00) in the forenoon (a.m.), at which time the polls will open, and seven o'clock (7:00) in the afternoon (p.m.), at which time the polls will close, to vote by Australian ballot upon the following Article of business:

ARTICLE 1

Shall the Town of Elmore vote to authorize the Select Board to spend a sum of money not more than Three Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$370,000) for the support of purchasing a new truck for the Elmore Fire Department to replace a 1979 International Pumper, financing for a period not to exceed Ten Years.

The legal voters of the Town of Elmore are further notified that voter qualification, registration and absentee voting relative to said special meeting shall be as provided in Chapters 43,51 and 55 of Title 17, Vermont Statutes annotated. Persons residing within the Town who are not on the checklist, or who wish to vote by absentee ballot, are directed to contact the Town Clerk.

The legal voters of the Town of Elmore are further notified that there will be two informational meetings held to answer questions on this article.

- **Tuesday, February 19, 2019** at six o'clock (6:00) in the evening (p.m.) at the Town Office in the Town of Elmore and,
- **Tuesday, February 26, 2019** at seven o'clock (7:00) in the evening (p.m.) at the Elmore Fire Dept. in the Town of Elmore.

These meetings will provide additional information on the proposed purchase of a Fire truck and related town budget and estimated tax impact. Content discussed in each meeting will be the same. Two meeting times are offered to give Elmore residents multiple opportunities to ask questions and gain additional information.
