Ongoing Business:

Zoning/subdivision regulations update w/ Seth Jensen Most of the draft is complete. There are a few last points that need to be cleared up. The big issue is how to figure out how many lots you are going to have in a conservation subdivision. Current language is setup in a one-size-fits-all situation. However, there are a couple more options. Seth Jensen explained the options (hand out). Depending on the option that is decided upon, the work that is required to determine the constraints can go from simple to very complex. With Elmore's complex topography, the one-size fits all doesn't seem to be the right fit. Option 3 which is the most restrictive was decided as the best option to include in the zoning plan.

For issue 2, it was decided to not have a density bonus since the only reasons to support a density bonus and who would receive it, have already been addressed in other areas of the plan.

For issue 3, it was decided to not include conservation subdivision on multiple contiguous and non-contiguous parcels.

Seth went over the remaining sections that need review. – Height requirements – Certificates of Compliance and inspection of Improvements – Village District Zoning Bylaw -

Update on 5k race planning progress

Currently 61 people are signed up. If race-day registration is going to happen, registration will need to happen where there is internet. A device will be needed in order to support the registration. The last minute registration information will need to be

Tickets will be handed out with the bibs. The raffle tickets will have the bib number labeled on it. Raffles will be chosen during the race.

Prior to the race, the raffle prizes will be listed on the website. The discussion of sharing some of the funds that are being given from Copley and giving some funds to some of the folks who put in donations. There will be some money set aside to help start the planning for a similar race next year. Some of the funds will be used to buy fruit in addition to the water and garuka bars at the finish line. There will be a quick discussion on Aug 8 at 11 to help prepare/finalize some things.
