Minutes:

- Development concerns update
 - o Previously we had discussed a “welcome to Elmore” packet for all potential new Elmore residents.
 - o Packet would include a little bit of Elmore history, why we have the restrictions we do and a link to the zoning by-laws
 - Provide edited by-laws based on the location: forest, lake district, etc
 - o This will be a project that will be put together over the next couple of months with the strategy of how to roll this out moving forward.
- 5k run wind down
 - o All positive comments
 - o Dealing with the various expenses at this point, but at the moment it appears that it did better than break even.
 - o The State Park charged the town for parking and the invoice was unexpected. The park charged for 3 spectators and 1 biker for the gravel ride. This will need to be better organized for next year
 - o Another item that will need to be clarified for next year is that the raffle tickets need to be put in the jars at registration time and not after the race
 - o Possible associate tickets to the bib number. Possible organize a bit more ahead of time.
 - o Michelle to put together the thank you letters for all the volunteers and donors.
 - o Bruce will send out a save the date reminder for next year
