#### **A. SPECIAL TOPICS:** (Items requiring expanded discussion)

1. DISCUSSION: Elmore Fire Dept. Building Repairs: Review responses to RFP. Determine next actions.

ACTION: ESB, in 20 minute (1920hr-1940hr) executive session, reviewed RFP submission and selected Vermont Vernacular Designs.

R. Wills will review quote for accuracy and scope of work and VVD will be contacted.

ESB recommends replacement of existing failed chimney with Stainless Metalbestos ™ installation for maintenance free and leak resistance.

#### **B. NEW ITEMS:** (Schedule, minimum. 1 wk. prior to meeting)

1. UPDATE: VLT Requested Town endorsement of continued Forest Legacy Project Funding to secure conservation easements on larger tracts of undeveloped land.

ACTION: Endorsement letter sent. Continues support first approved in 2014.

2. DISCUSSION/ACTION: Elmore participation in U. S. Census Bureau LUCA program (Local Update of Census Addresses) to reconcile Grand List vs Census data. Preparation for 2020 Census.

ACTION: After review of the total required town work obligation (approximately .4 person years), ESB elected NOT to actively participate for this cycle due to manpower and cost.

- **3. UPDATE: Wind/Rain Storm Damage Assessment completed and sent to AOT.** Elmore damage insufficient for FEMA/VEMA aid/assistance.
- 4. EAGLE LEDGE ROAD: Preliminary request/proposal to seek grants to improve access in the East Elmore, Tallman Rd. area Dr. Carole Inge, Owner, Luke Hardt, Forester.

ACTION: Parties agreed to explore options for improved <u>access and enforcement</u> to better utilize this valuable regional asset. Private, Town and Regional options will be explored.

## C. CONTINUING ACTIVE ITEMS: (Update status, by item, by DRI)

1. STATUS UPDATE: Road Commissioner - LaCasse

ACTIONS: Prolonged rains and severe wind event (29-30 Oct) caused minor erosion to town roads. Most tree damage occurred in Bedell Brook area. Elmore Mtn. Rd closed for 3-4 hours.

WORK: Clean up storm damage, most roads graded, 2 culverts changed, Scheduled ditch work completed, Hauled ½ of needed mud season gravel

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EQUIPMENT: Preparations for winter, fluids & lubes, tires, reconfigure all equipment for cold weather operations.

EMPLOYEES: All present and accounted for.

PLANS: Finish gravel stockpile, Update Priority List, LCPC Erosion Inventory, New truck 2018, Identify \$ to repair Ice House Road Culvert

- 2. UPDATE: ANR Storm Water Management: MRGP comment period closed. Proposed onerous and costly regulations based on Act 64. Lamoille County towns sent 8 pages of modifications. Significant town cost increases plus direct property owner costs and alterations.
- 3. STATUS UPDATE: Bridge #14, Bedell Brook: Sheared approach rails and channel realignment to eliminate scour of abutment.

ACTION: Will be addressed in spring. Special equipment & approvals needed to repair rails and remediate scour. Temporary reflectors will be explored.

- 4. UPDATE EPC:
  - a. ENERGY PLAN: Draft Energy Plan review by PSB resulted in changes/suggestions. LCPC & EPC to resolve and resubmit.
  - b. TOWN PLAN: Update due 2018 = MAJOR EFFORT/WORK necessary.
    - i. Burley met with EPC 25 Oct Review and create measurable Goals and Sub-goals.
    - ii. Plan to significantly reduce current 88 pages. Separate background info from specific actions Town can achieve.
- 5. **UPDATE: Elmore Water System- ACTION:** Brooke Green & Abram Ward late payment issue resolved, payment received as result of Jon Osborn meeting with Green/Ward.
